SUBJECT: Sexual Assault Prevention and Response (SAPR) Training for all U.S. Army Garrison, Japan Department of Defense Employees

1. REFERENCES:

- a. AR 600-20, Army Command Policy, Chapter 8, 18 March 2008.
- b. AR 690-600, Equal Employment Opportunity Discrimination Complaints, 9 Feb 2004.

2. PURPOSE: To establish a command policy for all U.S. Army Garrison, Japan (USAG-J) Department of Defense (DoD) employees to attend annual sexual assault prevention and response training IAW AR 600-20.

3. GENERAL:

- a. Sexual Assault is a crime and will not be tolerated in the military or military community.
- b. This policy is to ensure all personnel within USAG-J communities are aware of prevention, intervention, and reporting options for victims of sexual assault.
- c. This policy reinforces the DoD SAPR Program.

4. APPLICABILITY: This policy letter applies to all military personnel and DoD civilians assigned, attached, or under operational control of USAG-J. All installation partners are invited to attend this annual training.
